EXPERIENCE WELLINGTON

1 Connect with local and international art at **City Gallery**, experience the stories of our history at **Wellington Museum**, take a quick trip in the iconic **Cable Car** to some of Wellington's top views and when you feel on top of the world look to the heavens at **Space Place**.

CULINARY CAPITAL

2 Wellington's reputation as New Zealand's culinary capital is well-deserved: we have more eateries and bars per capita than New York City. Get the full Wellington gastronomic experience with coffee in the roasteries down **Jessie and College Streets**, dine at an acclaimed eatery in **Cuba Street**, and end with a perfectly made cocktail in **Courtenay Place**.

CRAFT BEER

3 This easily walked trail will take you to all our central city brew pubs. It pays homage to the local breweries who welcome you in for a drink alongside their stainless steel. Start in **Bond Street**, down **Ghuznee Street** and culminate at the iconic Garage Project in **Aro Street**.

SHOPPING

4 Shopping in Wellington is a delight - not only because of the range of stores, but the city's compact nature means it's very walkable. Start out shopping the high street stores on **Lambton Quay**, carry on through the home-grown designer stores in **Victoria and Willis Streets** and end up browsing wonderfully weird stores on **Cuba Street**, all in an afternoon.

WALK FROM TĀKINA

5 Stretch your legs and enjoy the **Writer's Walk** a ten-minute walk from Tākina down the Wellington Waterfront, printed word becomes visual art in this showcase of Wellington's contribution to New Zealand's literary culture. Finishing up for the day early? Soak up the sun on a stroll of picturesque **Oriental Bay**.

GET ACTIVE

6 Nestled between hills and harbour, you're never far from nature in Wellington. Visit **Zealandia Te Māra a Tāne** a world-first, fully fenced eco-sanctuary just ten minutes' drive from the city, kayak on the harbour to explore **Oriental Bay**, or go for a hike at **Mount Victoria Lookout** to explore **Oriental Bay**, Māori culture in the cultural precinct on the **Waterfront** and **Te Aro Pā** visitor center in Taranaki St, and history and art all around the city.

7 You'll find plenty to inspire you in Wellington - movie making magic and award-winning museums, world-class performing arts down **Cambridge Terrace** and **Courtenay Place**, Māori culture in the cultural precinct on the **Waterfront** and **Te Aro Pā** visitor center in Taranaki St, and history and art all around the city.
